Not to mention rolling back out, after filling their faces with enormous gyros and thick wedges of moussaka your ya-ya would heartily approve of.

Get a tzatziki, because it should go without saying.

Get a taramosalata because you always get tzatziki.

Get the grilled octopus because it has that proper char and fantastic squidge.

Get a saganaki. Get a Dakos salad. Get a biftekia. Get a souvlaki.

Get a group together and head down en masse so you can be absolutely certain you've tried as much as possible in one sitting. Because it's that good, and even better value.
