Mythos Urban Greek Eatery: Minimal elegance in City Walk

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Located at The Square in Dubai's City Walk, Mythos Urban Greek Eatery is from the same folks behind [Mythos in JLT](#) - one of The HUNTR's favourite little Greek kouzinas. Featuring upscale vibes and luxurious finishings, this elegant restaurant first opened its doors in January 2023 and offers a contemporary Greek dining experience in the heart of Jumeirah, with a licensed bar and an expansive space...



Complete with a beautiful open kitchen, framed by hanging dried herbs and flowers, Mythos Urban Greek Eatery is the perfect place to enjoy a special meal with friends, family, or clients. Design by Athens-based design studio Stones & Walls, there is a beautiful al fresco seating area (which was unfortunately closed when The HUNTR visited due to heavy rains), and various seating arrangements for all group sizes. The natural colour palette adds a calming, warm ambiance, and the cosy corners make it the kind of spot you want to while away a whole afternoon...



The HUNTR kickstarted our experience with a couple of cocktails at the bar - a small and cosy enclave at the back of the restaurant. We tried and loved the Estia (60AED) with Amaretto, Greek yogurt, lemon, mint, and gomme syrup, and the Greek Aftertaste (65AED) crafted with London Dry gin, elderflower, lemon, cucumber, dill, and angostura bitters.

The drinks menu features an eclectic wine list with the opportunity to sample some of Greece's delicious indigenous grape varieties alongside craft cocktails, mocktails, spirits, beers and more.



With our appetites suitably whetted, we sat down for a late lunch. The food menu offers a tempting array of Greek dishes, which are perfect for sharing and meticulously curated by Mythos' Group Culinary Director and Chef Ilias Kokoroskos.

Finding it hard to resist the complimentary bread basket and Kalamata olives, we then dived into the moreish Charcoal Grilled Pita Bread (8AED) with two iconic Greek dips - the Fava (32AED) and Mythos' incredible, tangy, creamy, addictive Tzatziki (30AED).

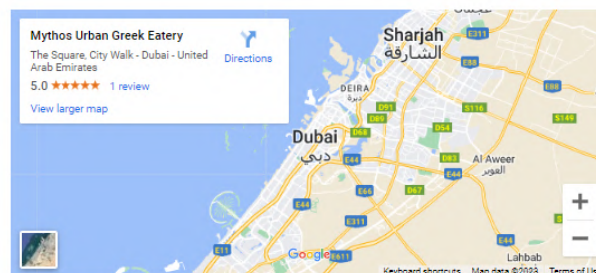
We then shared the bright and zesty Horiatiki (47AED) salad with feta, tomatoes, cucumber, green bell pepper, onions, Kalamata olives, oregano, and olive oil. Which was perfectly matched with the tender, deliciously charred Grilled Octopus (95AED), which comes pre-sliced on skewers and features a garnishing of fava beans, caramelized onions, and caper leaves.

For the main event, we shared the Bifteкия (84AED) - hearty, rich lamb and beef patties with sautéed slices of thin potatoes and kefalograviera; to die for. Plus the Spring Chicken Lemanto (102AED) - baby chicken, cut into quarters, cooked in lemon sauce, feta, oregano and served with chunky Greek fries. Tender, juicy, flavourful... What more could you want? And for the side, Kolokythakia (28AED) - crispy, deep fried baby marrow.

To finish a wonderful lunch, we couldn't resist ordering the Galaktobourekakia (45AED), another Mythos icon - three crispy filo rolls filled with creamy vanilla custard, topped with a sticky, sweet glaze. Heaven in a bite, and perfect with coffee - we had an Americano (23AED) and a Cappuccino (25AED).



Insider tips: Advanced bookings highly recommended, especially for busy periods and big groups. There's also a lovely retail corner, the ideal spot to purchase a foodie gift.
